## "Authority and Submission"

- --> not authority of believer over works of hell (will study another time)
  - \* we were formerly dominated by demonic
  - \* the great invasion taking back our lost territory
    - 1 Pet 3:22...Jesus is above all
    - John 5:27...Jesus' authority to execute judgment

| Matt 21:23-27 | Who gave you this authority? = privilege freedom release delegated influence capacity competency right Who said you could?

- \* only God can = has authority on earth to forgive and heal (Mark)
  - has source beyond the person
  - something given to person

| Matt 7:24-29 | His words came with authority = moved into allotted realm, knew whereof He spoke, more than words

- \* sensed authority of His words
  - freedom and mastery in His words
- \* pattern for authoritative counsel
  - not demand obedience
  - just spoke truth
  - cannot mandate someone's submission..."I have no voice to you"
  - --> \* authority is something you have = can be sensed more than dynamic or personality
    - guru ≠ 0 -
    - \* authority is <u>not</u> something you wield or require
    - \* only God gives authority (spiritual) --> free to oppose but will suffer consequences

| Matt 20:17-28 | Exercise authority = to have control of, to be above in rank to be <u>privileged</u> over \_\_\_\_\_ bring under the power of

> \* God's delegated authority does not put you above anyone; it simply gives weight and substance to you

\* that's why submission = reflexive verb --> submit selves

Heb 13:17 | --> Obey and submit because they watch out for you

- they have authority (insight, understanding, freedom) to care for you
- (1) God <u>made</u> demons subject to Jesus' name our spirits subject to us creation subject to futility
- (2) God <u>advises</u> wives to submit to husbands all to submit to governments all to submit to one another

1 Tim 2:12 --> not allow a woman to "act of oneself" over a man dominate self-sufficient make as if only one crowd out
