A Study In II Corinthians

Chapter 4:1-2

- (1) People lose heart when they lose sight of mercy and the hope of being changed.
- (2) Fear of condemnation makes us hide shameful things; the New Covenant gives us courage to confess and renounce them.
- (3) People can, and do, use the Bible for their own purposes.
- (4) The only basis for our approach to people should be the Truth and how we have responded to it.

Chapter 4:3-6

- (1) Not everyone can see the "good" and the hope in the Truth.
- (2) Satan can, and does, blind people's eyes from seeing the Truth.
- (3) Our only role in people's lives should be that of a servant.
- (4) The light of Truth in our lives reflects to other people what knowing God is like.
