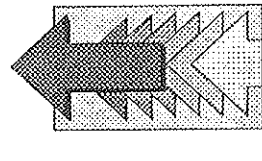
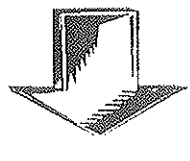
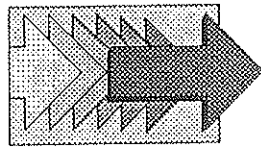
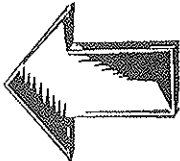
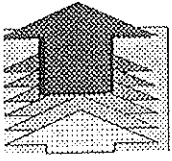


The Coastlands Does God Know Where I Am? Dr. Daniel A. Brown
